Guests are only allowed in the pool area with a resident of the community.

Any person under the age of fourteen (14) is not permitted in the pool unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian or an adult (18 yrs or older). Regarding Spa use: Please be advised that extremely hot water is potentially dangerous to young children and the elderly and not advised.

# **DUMPSTER ENCLOSURES**

Trash must be bagged and placed <u>INSIDE</u> the dumpsters, not just in the dumpster enclosures. Please take the extra step to ensure your community is clean. Open garbage attracts rats, bugs and other unwanted pests. If you know the dumpster is full, please take your garbage to another dumpster enclosure. Republic Services will not empty out the



Hazardous materials and large items such as mattresses, appliances and furniture may not be placed in the community dumpsters. If an item protrudes out of the dumpster or will not fit in the dumpster at all, it needs to be taken directly to the dump. Republic Services will charge the Association for over-filled dumpsters. Any resident caught leaving large items in or around the dumpsters can be fined up to \$1,000.
